Finances at St. Mary's and St. John Bosco

As stated last week, going on last year's expenditure, we are only £4,000 short of having a year's expenditure in our account to cover any emergencies and to run efficiently. However, our expenditure has exceeded our income so far this year by £16,000 due to the necessary building work. This is still an amazing figure as our building costs have been £24,000. These costs will rise by roughly another £10,000 in order to complete the work at St. John Bosco Presbytery.
