Catechism on The Holy Eucharist

The Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist is the true Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, together with His Soul and Divinity, under the appearances of bread and wine. The bread and wine are changed into the Body and Blood of Christ by the power of God, to whom nothing is impossible or difficult.

In order to receive the Blessed Sacrament worthily it is required that we be in a state of grace, and have fasted 1 hour before receiving. (Water does not break this fast.)

To be in a state of grace is to be free from mortal sin, and pleasing to God. It is a great sin to receive Holy Communion in mortal sin, "for those that eat and drink unworthily, eat and drink judgment to themselves."

The Sacrifice of the Mass is offered for four ends: first, to give supreme honour and glory to God; secondly, to thank Him for all His benefits; thirdly, to obtain pardon for our sins; and fourthly, to obtain all other graces and blessings through Jesus Christ.

The UK Parliament – The House of Commons – voted by 379 to 137 on Tuesday to decrimalise abortion. Neil O'Brien MP, Harborough voted against; Shockat Adam MP, Leicester South abstained and Liz Kendall MP, Leicester West voted for the amendment. Please pray that the House of Lords will overturn this disgusting amendment and that the unborn will be protected.
