New Thursday Evening Mass – Beginning 21/8/25

In response to the Mass time questionnaire, I am delighted to introduce a new **midweek evening Mass**. This will be from the regular Missal but will take the form of a votive mass when permitted.

Why an extra Mass? Because renewal begins at the altar.

This Mass is offered:

- For the renewal of our parishes
- In **reparation** for our sins and those of the world
- For the souls of our faithful departed
- For all **personal intentions** laid before Christ

What Is a Votive Mass?

A Votive Mass is a special Mass offered for a particular intention, rather than the celebration assigned for that day in the Church's calendar. It might be celebrated in honour of the Sacred Heart, Our Lady, St Joseph, or for a specific need such as peace, the sick, or vocations. These Masses are usually offered on weekdays in Ordinary Time, when no feast or solemnity is prescribed. The word votive comes from the Latin votum, meaning a vow or intention. In short, a Votive Mass allows us to focus our prayer and liturgy on a particular mystery of faith or special need—an opportunity for deeper devotion.

Beginning Thursday 21st August and continuing every Thursday I am available, we will celebrate a weekly 6:30pm Mass at St. Mary's with English and Latin chant, incense, Roman Canon and the priest facing the altar together with the people (ad orientem). If this is not for you, remember it is an extra, you don't have to be there but do pray for our efforts and those who would appreciate it. I do not have a Latin background so I will need to improve over time, please be patient with me.

Why Chant? Because chant is the Church's own voice.

"The Church acknowledges Gregorian chant as specially suited to the Roman liturgy; therefore, it should be given pride of place." — GIRM §41

Why Incense? Because incense is biblical.

"Let my prayer rise before you like incense." — Psalm 141:2

"An angel came and stood at the altar... and the smoke of the incense rose with the prayers of the saints." — Revelation 8:3–4 Incense reminds us of heaven. It signifies the sacred, the mysterious, and the **prayer of the Church rising to God**.

Why Ad Orientem? Because facing the East isn't about turning our backs — it's a turning towards the Lord. "Looking at the priest has no importance. What matters is looking together at the Lord." — Pope Benedict XVI. The priest and people together face the same direction — towards the Lord. We look together for the Lord returning from the East during the Eucharistic Prayer (ad orientem means towards the east). <u>Come and See:</u> This Mass is **open to all**. You don't need to understand Latin or chant to enter into it. Let it wash over you. Whether you come every week or just once in a while, let this be your **anchor in the week** — a moment of reverence, silence, and heavenly beauty.

Q: Do I need to know Latin?

A: No. Everything is printed with English alongside. Join in as you're comfortable. Latin is the language of the Roman Rite and has been used in the Church's liturgy for over 1,500 years. This isn't a "different" Mass—it's the same, simply enriched by elements that remind us we are part of the Church through time and across the world.

Q: Will this replace other Masses?

A: No. It is an **extra opportunity** for worship. If ad orientem is not your thing, don't worry about it.

Q: Can I bring children?

A: Absolutely.
