“Rejoice, the Saviour Is Near”

Gaudete Sunday stands out in Advent like a candle in the dark. The Church wears rose, the music softens, and a single word rises above the rest: **Rejoice**.

But Christian joy is never naïve.

It doesn't pretend that December is peaceful or that life is perfect.

It is not the cheerfulness of avoiding reality.

It is the confidence that **God has entered reality** — and that He comes as **Saviour**.

John the Baptist sits in prison this week.

He sends a question to Jesus that many of us have whispered in our own way: “Are You the One who is to come?”

In other words:

“Can I trust You with my life? With my fears? With my soul?”

And Jesus answers not with mere words but with signs of salvation: the blind see, the lame walk, the poor hear Good News.

Every healing is a reminder that God has come not simply to improve life, but to save souls — to restore what sin has damaged, to lift what has fallen, to open what has been closed.

We rejoice this week, not because everything is solved, but because the Saviour is already at work.

John is still in prison, yet Christ is freeing hearts.

We may feel burdened, yet Christ is healing wounds we cannot see.

Grace is growing beneath the surface.

Light is gathering at the horizon.

Gaudete Week invites each of us to pause and ask a simple question: “Where is Christ already working in my life?”

Look for the small mercies, the quiet conversions, the daily strength you did not generate on your own.

These are His footprints.

As Christmas draws near, let this be our Advent prayer:

“Lord Jesus, You are the One who has come to save me.

Give me the joy that comes from trusting You.”

Rejoice — the Saviour is very near.
