that they may recognise the voice of Christ calling them, and respond with trust and generosity to the path God has prepared for them.

**For the sick, the suffering, and the dying:**

that the light of Christ may strengthen them, and that they may know the closeness of God's love and care.

**For the faithful departed:**

that all who have followed Christ in this life may share fully in the light of His eternal kingdom.
