Reader: For those who feel lonely, anxious, or far from God:
that they may discover in the Church a true spiritual home and know the healing love of the Father.
Lord, hear us.

Reader: For our parish community:
that nourished by the sacraments and united in charity, we may grow together in holiness and become faithful witnesses to Christ in the world.
Lord, hear us.

Reader: For the faithful departed:
that having passed through death in hope, they may now behold forever the glory of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit in heaven.
Lord, hear us.

Reader: Let us now offer our own prayers in silence. (pause)

Reader: Let us ask the prayers of Our Lady, daughter of the Father, mother of the Son, and spouse of the Holy Spirit. All: Hail Mary...

Priest: Father, through Your Son and in the Holy Spirit,
hear the prayers we place before You today.
Keep us always in Your love and bring us at last to the joy of eternal life.
